Different colours

There are sun lenses in different colours. Each colour has its own effect. Which colour sun lenses you choose depends on your preference. We list the different types of sun lenses:

- Grey sun lenses let you look most realistic as they do not affect ambient colours.
- Brown sun lenses are the most popular. And that makes pretty good sense. The warm brown colour does not let cool blue colours through as well, which makes everything look a bit sunnier.
- Max brown/orange sun lenses increase contrast. This can be extra nice in traffic, for example. You can easily see whether a traffic light is green or red and brake lights stand out better.
- Green sun lenses give a cooler image because they block yellow colours. This is nice
 when the sun shines brightly. Moreover, green lenses allow precisely the colours the
 human eye is most sensitive to pass through well. You can therefore look particularly
 clear and bright through them.

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With or without prescription

Every employee has a different eye strength and performs different work. We therefore offer different types of glass versions.

Single-vision

Single-vision spectacles are spectacles for better near vision or for better far vision. Single-vision glasses for near vision have a plus prescription in the lenses. This allows you to see sharply up close, for example to read a book. Single-vision glasses for distant vision have a minus prescription in the lenses. This allows you to see sharply in the distance, for example while driving. So single vision lenses have only one prescription.

Multifocal

Multifocal glasses allow you to see well both far away and up close. Multifocal lenses combine different prescriptions in one lens. Depending on where you look in the glasses, you can see very well at different distances: at reading distance, intermediate distance and far away. Without having to change glasses. Multifocal lenses (also called varifocal lenses or progressive lenses) allow you to see sharply both near and far.

As many as 85% of people over 40 need progressive lenses.

No prescription

If your employee has no prescription or wears lenses, we also supply non-prescription sunglasses.

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Glass thickness

Whichever glasses you choose, they can always be made extra thin. By default, glasses have a glass thickness of 1.5. The thinner the lenses, the lighter and more comfortable the glasses become.

The thickness of the glasses depends on several factors such as your prescription and the size of the frame. Glasses that are a bit thinner have a higher lens index, between 1.6 and 1.74. How thin your lenses will be depending on your prescription and the material of your frame. Our opticians will be happy to advise you on which lens thickness is best for you.
